

- **Ensure you have a Scran Stuff Password**

What is Stuff?

Stuff is your personal, password protected area on Scran. It's where you store or share your stuff.

Scribble uses the same password so that you only need to remember one. If you already have a Stuff password, log in to Scribble right away.

To Set up a Stuff Password

- Go to **How do I set up an Account** on the Scribble front page <http://scribble.scran.ac.uk>
- Click the link **Click to set up one now**
- Type in a username and password
- Type in your email address



First time users register for Personal Stuff

That's you set. That username and password is what you use to log in to both Stuff and Scribble.


Do I need to go to Scran or Stuff to use Scribble?

No - Scribble just uses the same password as Stuff. Once you have a Stuff password, you can go straight to Scribble at <http://scribble.scran.ac.uk>.

- **Logging in to Scribble**

The Scribble Front Page

Enter your Stuff Username and Password and click **Go**. You are now logged in and you can set up your profile or start blogging right away.

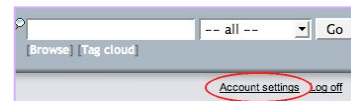

You can change your displayed name on Scribble. We use your Username to start-out. If your Username is an email, we anonymise it. Whatever is displayed though can be changed to something that suits you.

- Look at the Scran Scribble Logo. Now look along to the right just below the search box
- You will see **Account settings**
- Click **Account Settings**
- Type a new name to display and scroll down and click **Save**
